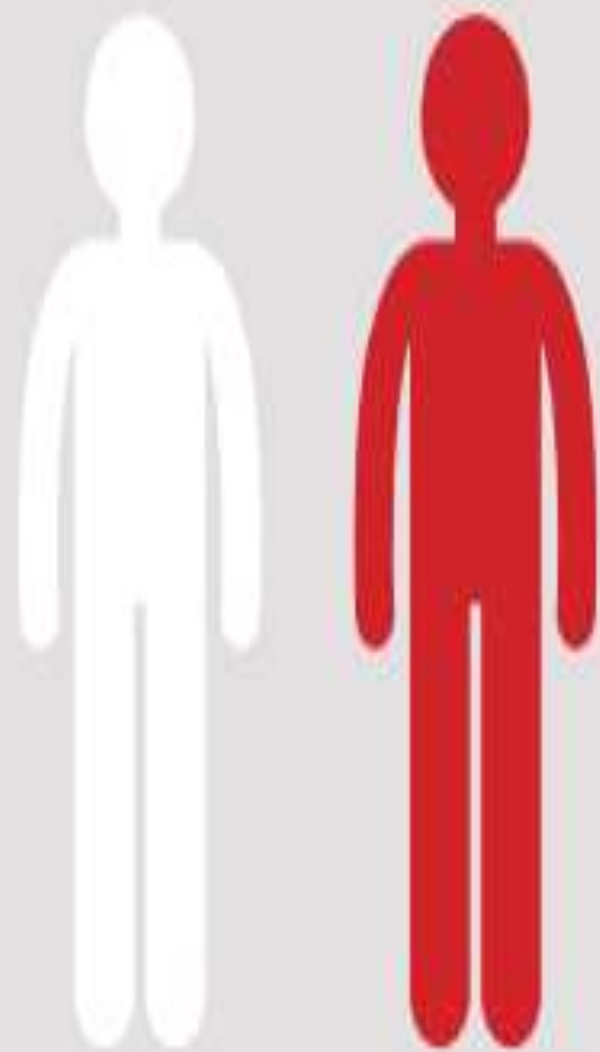

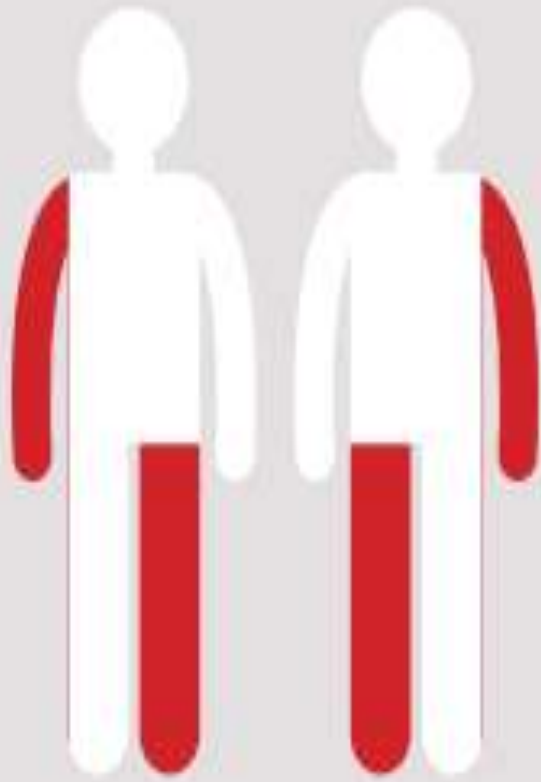

In **acute miasm** there is a large charge locally, which is intense and balances within a short period; the system remains intact and the patient does not begin to experience a chronic disease. A patient may go through an acute state to overcome a chronic disease. *Outbursts of latent psora according to Hahnemann.*

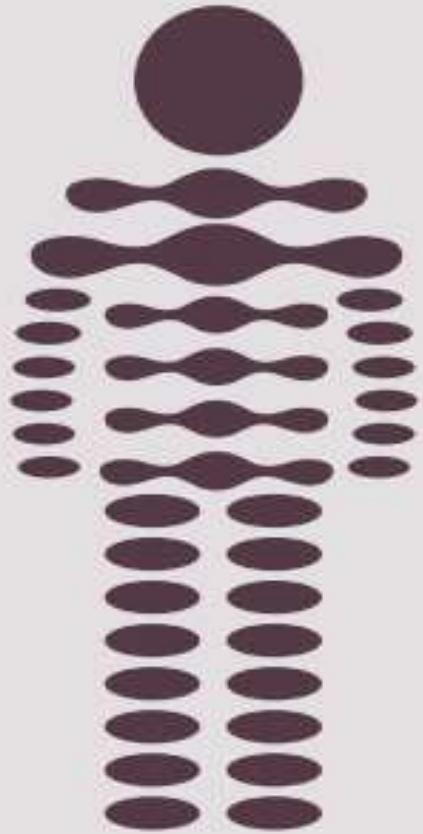


In **psoric miasm** (under stimulation of the organism), the system does not receive the energy it requires immediately, actually the rhythm of charging is altered; it is like a suspension of energy charging, a poor performance, but once it recovers, all systems shall be functioning properly, as if they had been left intact. The image shall be that of dry skin, eczemas etc, and the subject shall mostly be concerned about themselves.



In **sycotic miasm** (over or under local stimulation), an energy malfunction due to local contractions or impediments shall, through an energy alteration, induce over-activity of some systems, either in the same or different tissues. A typical image of discharges, skin warts, alternating arthritis (internal discharge). The subject is trying to control their surroundings.

Like an old battery the system has leakage of fluids



In **sypilitic miasm**, an energy malfunction shall induce a gap (the meaning of gap is usually between brain and heart) in energy distribution and pathology shall be concentrated in specific organs, particularly at night

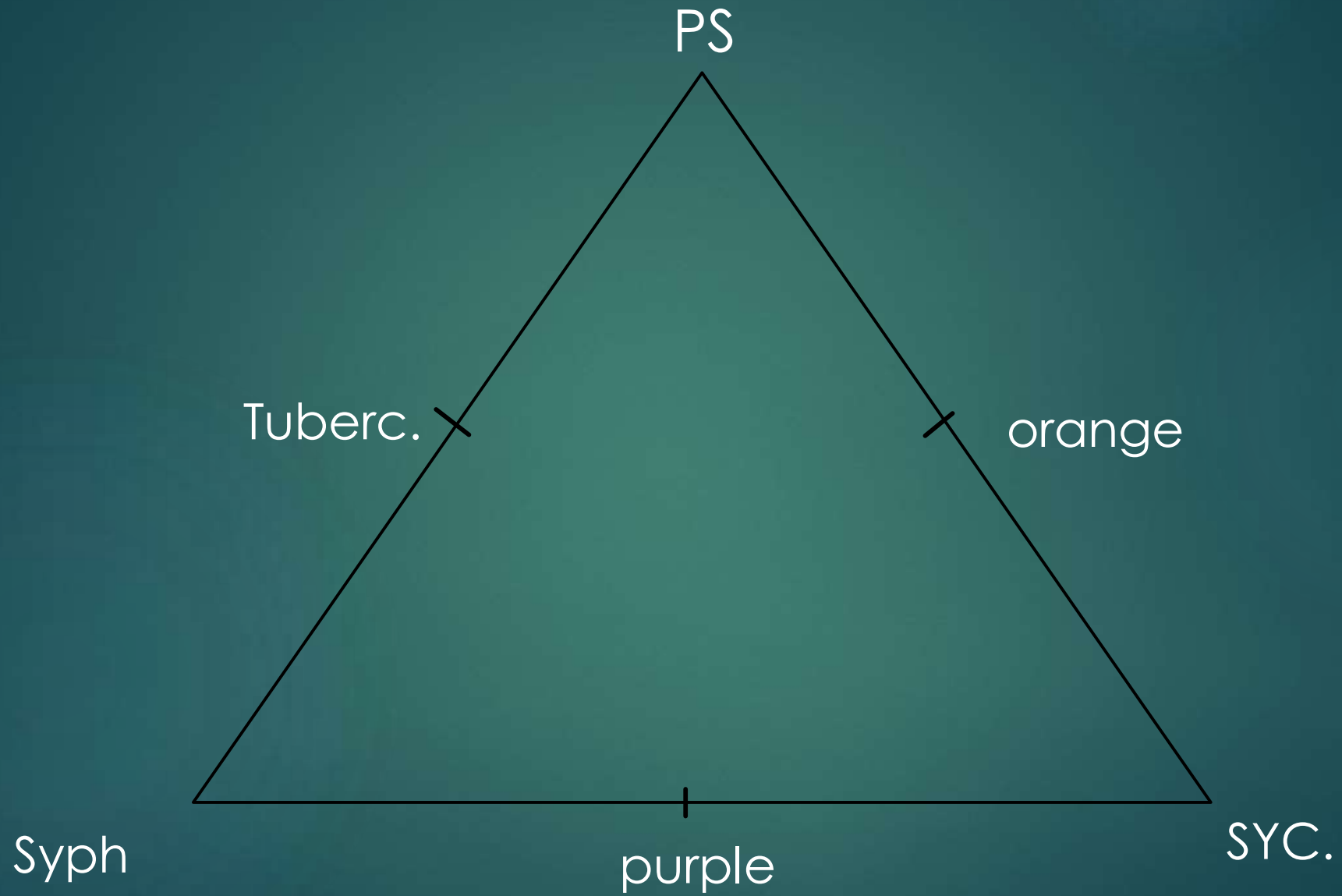

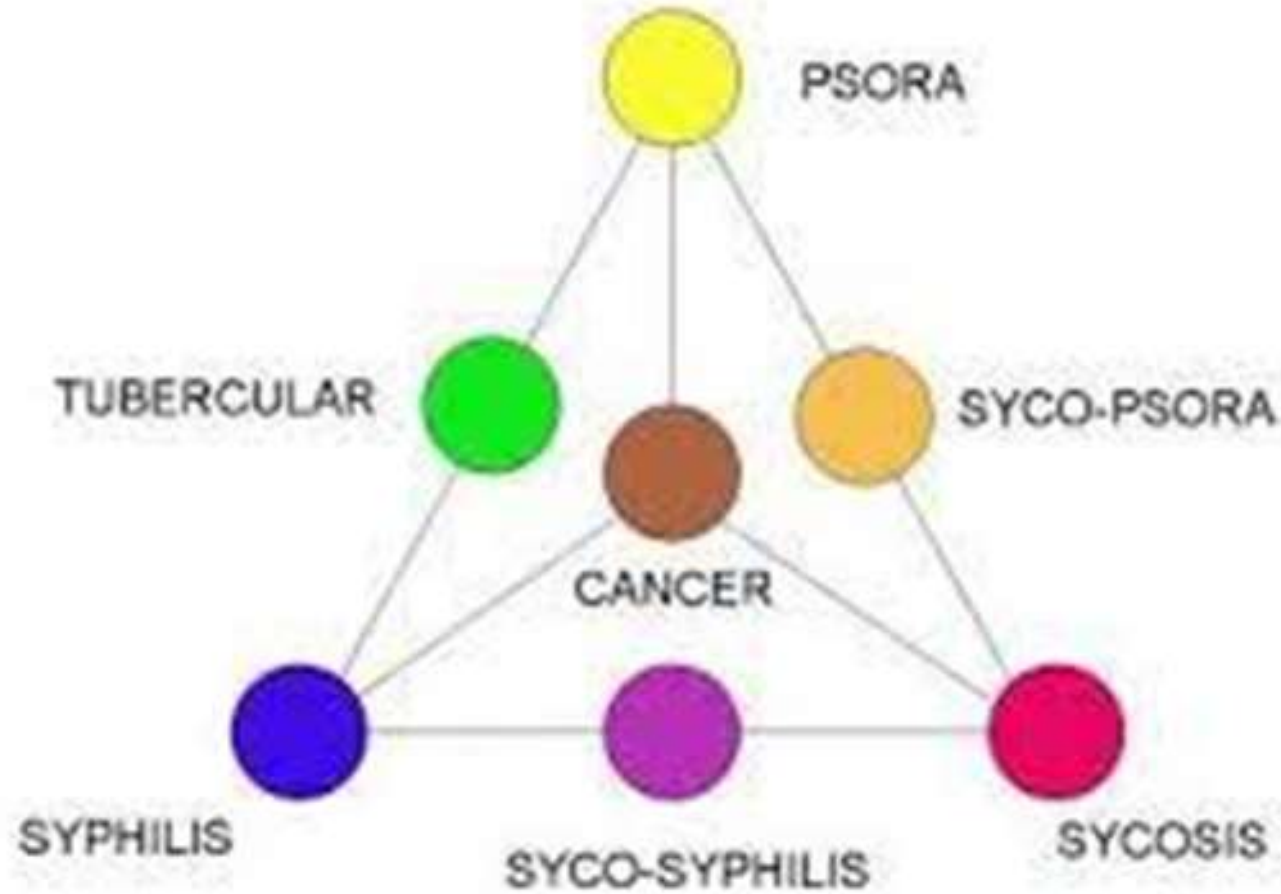

Modulates pruning of neurosis, which makes the brain more efficient, and maintains new synapses, particularly when learning new skills (91). It has also been suggested that REM sleep plays a role in regulating overnight amygdala reactivity, which may have implications for emotional regulation (92), since the amygdala is a key region involved in your emotion processing. This may explain why lack of sleep can often make us less able to deal with daily stress, and sometimes can cause us to overact and not be able to control our emotions as well as usual.

We then cycle into deeper stages of sleep, often also referred to as slow-wave sleep. Our heart rate and body temperature drop in deep sleep. During this stage, several important mechanisms associated with synaptic plasticity, the ability of the brain to grow and develop new connections, and memory consolidation (89) take place. Memory consolidation is the process by which new memories made when awake are transformed into stable representations and transferred into long term memory. In addition, the body repairs and regrows tissues, builds bone and muscle, and strengthens the immune system during deep sleep (88). We spend approximately 70% of our sleep cycle in non-REM deep sleep. REM sleep is associated with dreaming and is not considered a restful sleep stage. The brain is highly active throughout REM sleep, increasing brain metabolism by up to 20%. REM sleep is important because it further promotes consolidation (90).

Fantasies and delusions may, for the purpose of discovering compensation as well as other symbolic meanings, be treated in the same way as dreams.

We also are unable to indicate why certain mental characteristics are associated with certain physical disorder.



The conclusion is that in general an analogy of similar appearance may express a basic relationship, provided that this analogy covers a real totality (phenomenology)

The symbol (hidden meaning) can serve as a bridge to link and clarify for understanding the connection of outer substances to mental impulses and drug pathogenesis.

SYCOSIS

- ▶ No specific repetitive attacks that are blocking the options of apotoxinosis.
- ▶ If treated successfully return to a more balanced state (psor.).
- ▶ A major source of Sycosis is vaccination (Burnet's vaccines)
- ▶ Immune diseases (exaggeration).

- ▶ Psora is the most common hereditary disease.
 - ▶ Sycosis is the most common acquired (epigenetic) disease.
 - ▶ Hereditary psora —> toxic accumulation —> storage mechanisms —> Acquired Sycosis

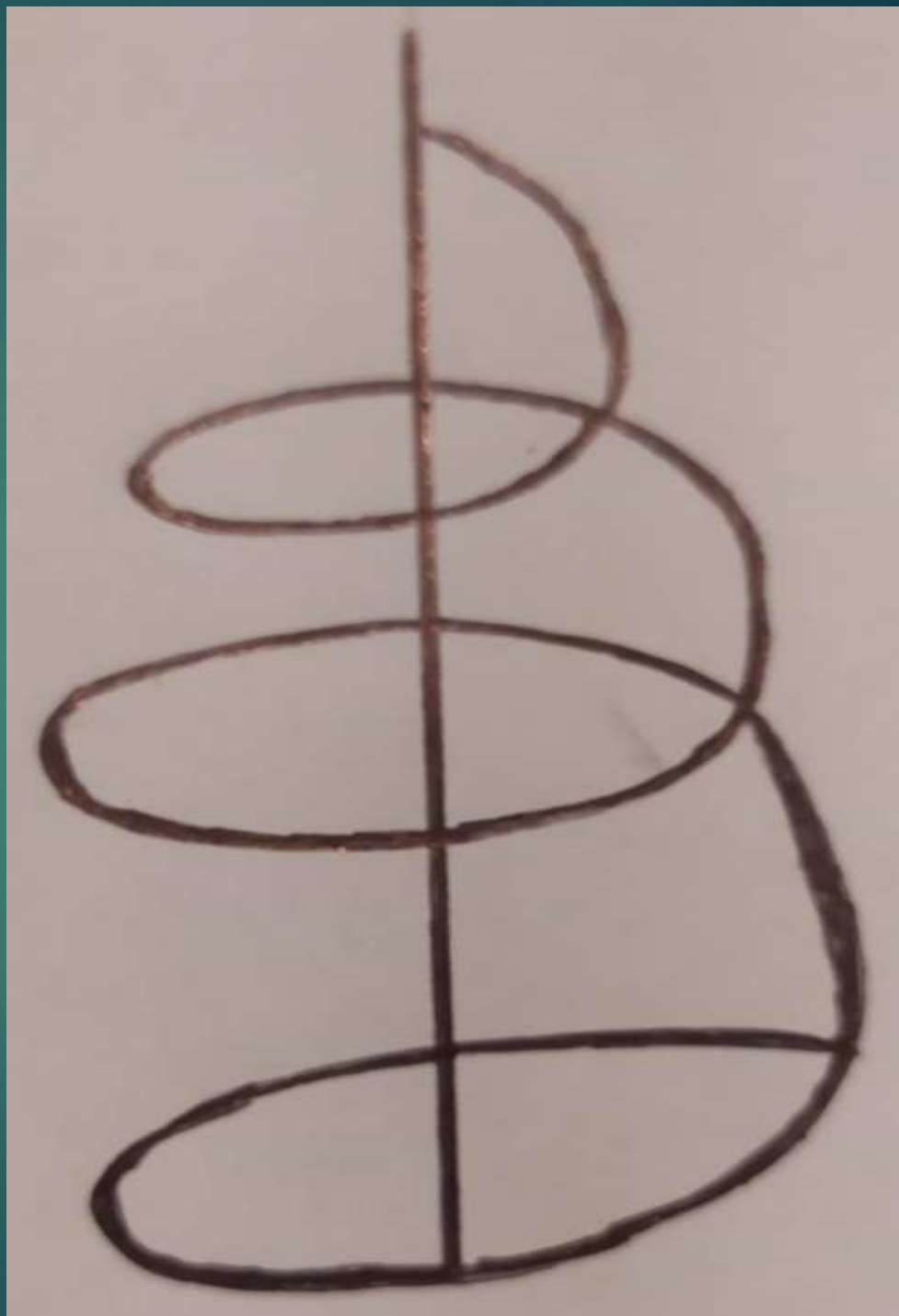

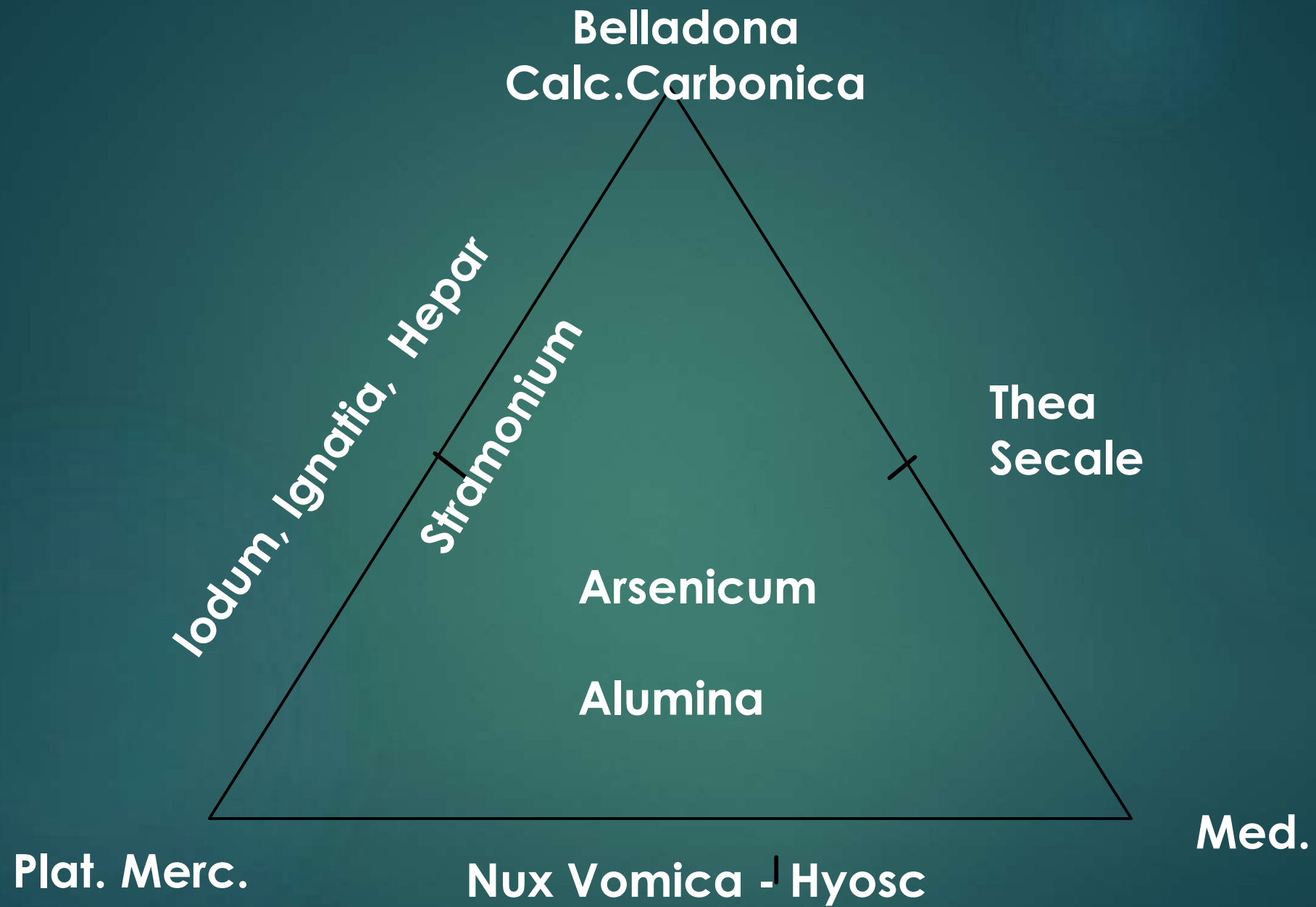
